forbidding the sale and usage of marijuana. This is not legal as only congress can legislate laws and rescind them.

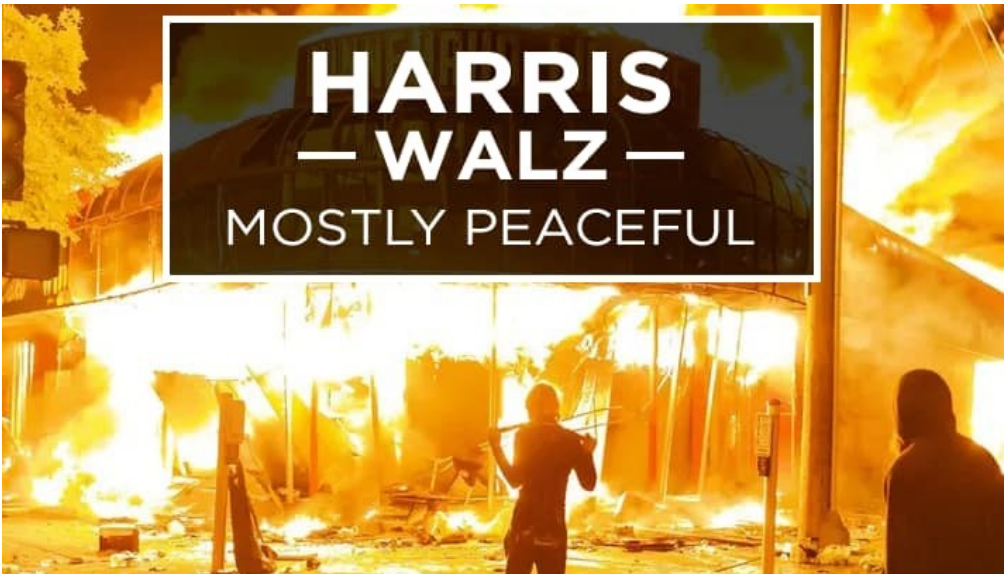
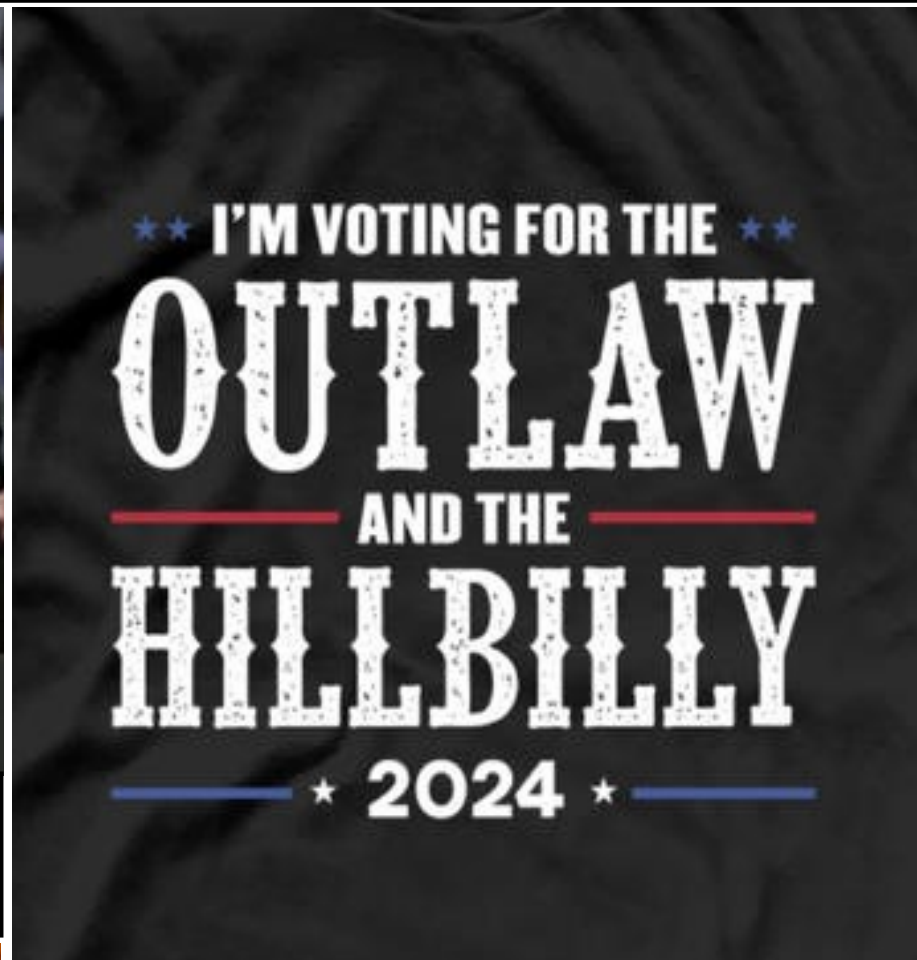

## Judge sides with Calif school that punished 1st grader for adding two inclusive words to Black Lives Matter drawing

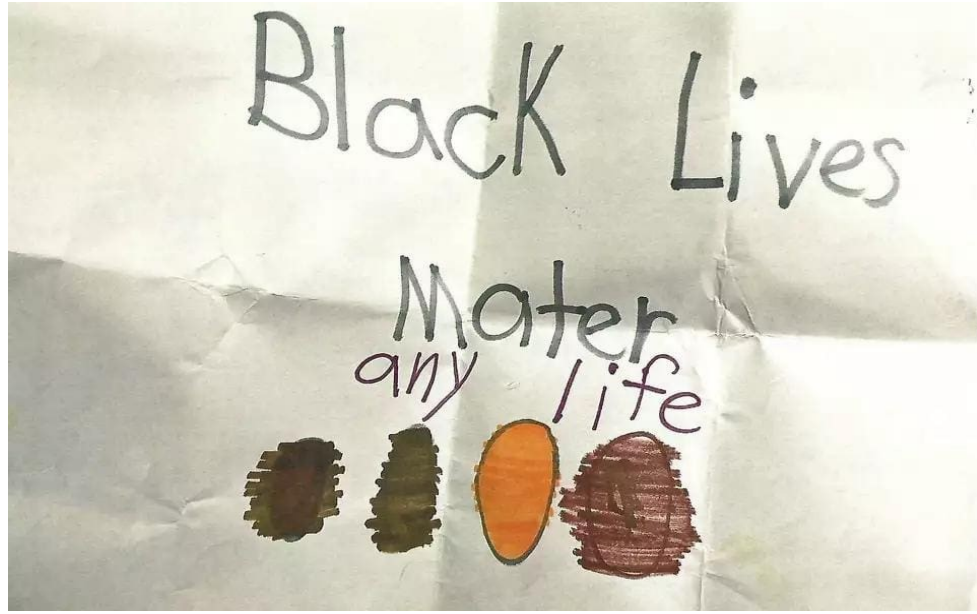
A leftist judge has ruled that a school was justified in punishing a 7-year-old 1st grader for inadvertently pointing out that all lives matter.

## Calif Senate Passes AB 1955

A "Government-Imposed Wall" Between Parents and Their Child

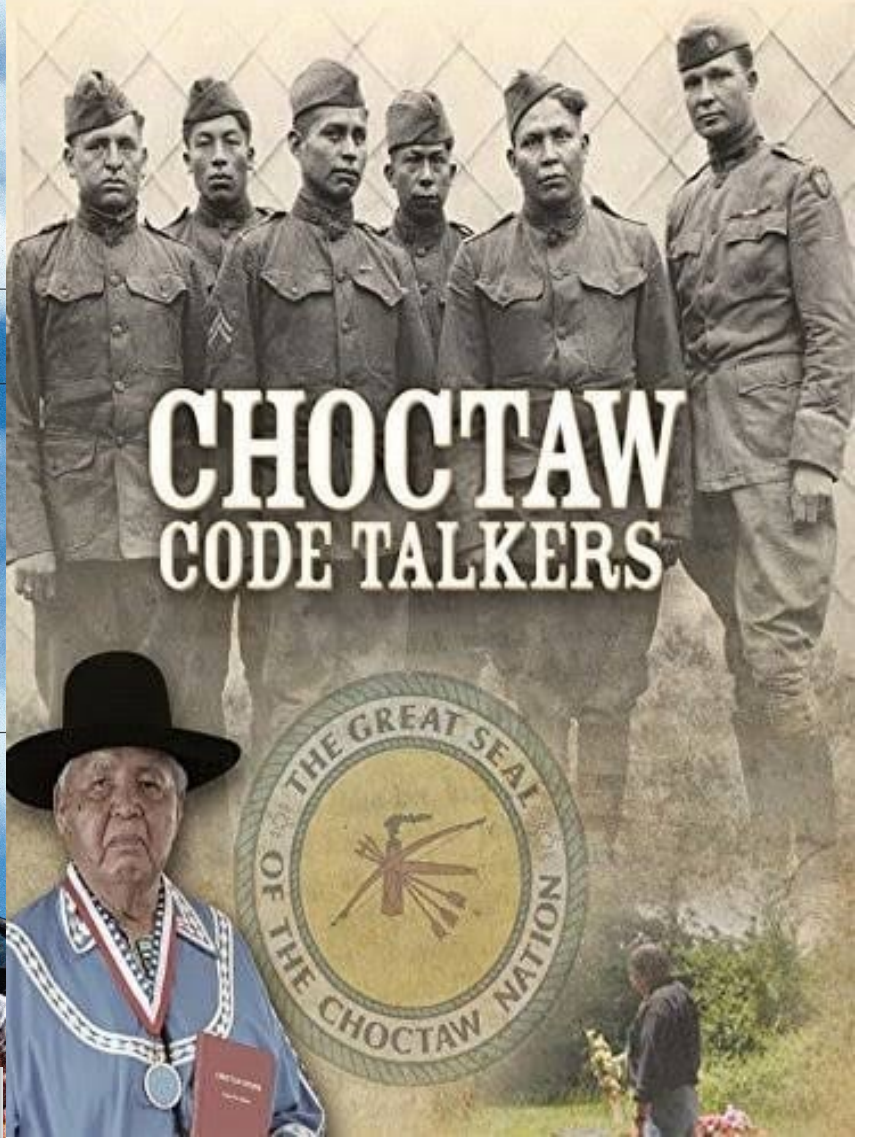

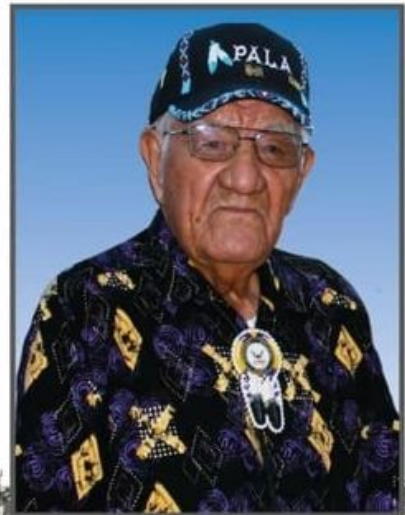

# Tribal economies benefit more than just tribes, new Fed research shows

Native American economic well being can “spillover” into a tribe’s neighbors. That means that strong Native economies can provide nearby communities with more business and wider access to federal contracts.

That’s per research by the Center for Indian Country Development at the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis. The Center hosted a webinar July 17 to discuss what the organization called “spillover” from surging revenues in tribal communities.

This spillover effect — while dependent on the type of Native business driving the revenues — could lead to improved economic well being not just for Natives, but non-Natives living nearby the affected communities, the CICD found.

Highlighting the interconnectedness, CICD Director Casey Lozar (Confederated Salish-Kootenai Tribes) pointed to his own tribe’s electronic manufacturing business, S&K Electronics Inc., as an example. The business, which is certified under the Small Business Administration’s 8(a) program, participates in the federal contracting sector.

S&K has created hundreds of jobs for both tribal community members and off-reservation residents, and has also created subcontracting opportunities for non-Native firms in the region, Lozar said during the webinar.

“There is a theme of connection and success through geographic place-based economic development,” Lozar said. “As a former board member and community member, I have witnessed firsthand the symbiotic relationship between tribally owned enterprises and local and regional economies.”

The webinar focused on two particular pieces of CICD research released in July: a [paper](#) on the spillover effects of the tribal gaming sector, and an [article](#) on spillover from federal contracting businesses. Indian gaming revenues topped \$41 billion this year, while federal contracting has become the second largest tribal revenue driver, per *Tribal Business News* reporting.

The paper on gaming focused on renewed economic activity around casinos post-pandemic. The study found that hospitality and leisure businesses within a mile and a half

of a reopened casino saw increased visitorship once the casino reopened. More generally, any businesses near a reservation saw an increase in visitors after casinos reopened.

“Our findings show that large-scale tribal investments such as Indian casinos on reservations could be a catalyst for regional development,” CICD Senior Research Assistant Elliot Charette, one of the study’s authors and a member of the Lac Du Flambeau and Red Cliff Bands of Lake Superior Chippewa, said during the event. “This interconnectedness provides additional rationale and incentives for closer economic cooperation between tribal and state governments.”

By comparison, the CICD research on federal contracting found that a significant portion of money that flows through tribal federal contracting companies ends up with small businesses as subcontractors. In some cases, tribes will subcontract parts of a larger federal project to other small businesses due to their specialization or location.

In 2022, the CICD reported that the federal government awarded

\$16.6 billion in prime contracts to Native-owned businesses. Roughly 7.1%, or \$1.2 billion, of that money went to other, subcontracted small businesses.

This practice can help small businesses continue to compete amid contract consolidation, the combination of smaller contracts into a larger one. Those consolidations can prove difficult bids for Native companies unless they use subcontractors to help in a wider range of competencies.

The process creates a cycle that allows Native companies to accept a wider variety of contracts and small businesses to acquire needed experience for their portfolios.

“Larger contracts are being awarded to bigger companies, and it’s harder for some businesses to compete,” said CICD Policy Assistant and article co-author Jacqui Baldwin-LeClair. “That’s why we wanted to look at that subcontracting connection — with subcontracting by Native-owned enterprises, we see those small businesses getting an opportunity to get experience, which is necessary to later acquire those larger contracts.”

# Record High: Tribal entities won \$23.3 billion in federal contracts in fiscal 2023 & Up in Fy25

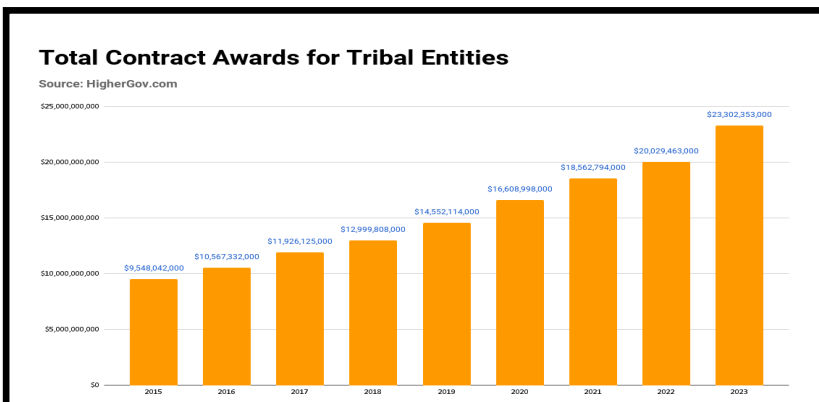
The U.S. government, the world’s largest buyer of goods and services, increased its purchasing to record levels last year and that was very good news for tribal entities in the federal contracting sector.

The surge in federal buying during fiscal 2023 helped push contract awards to tribal entities to record heights last year. Federal awards to tribal enterprises increased to a record \$23.3 billion in fiscal 2023, a 16.3% increase over fiscal 2022, according to exclusive data provided to *Tribal Business*

*News* by HigherGov, a market intelligence firm that tracks federal contracting.

The increase of \$3.3 billion in awards to tribal entities last year was due primarily to double-digit growth in federal contracts from the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) versus the prior fiscal year.

Meyers has over 20-years experience in Federal 8(a) Contracting and has met with several small tribes that seem to balk at the amount of funding that is available. “It’s serious money,” he said.



Contract awards for tribal entities have grown for eight straight years, according to market intelligence firm HigherGov data.

## Cheryl Miller All America \* All World Basketball Icon



Cheryl Miller took women's basketball off the court and into the air above the rim. With tremendous grace and athletic dexterity, Miller established a legacy throughout her high school and college career that is unparalleled. Playing for Riverside (CA) Polytechnic High School, Miller set the single game record of 105 points in a 1982 game against Notre Vista High School. As a collegiate forward at the University of Southern California from 1982 to 1986, Miller helped bring women's basketball to the forefront of American sports. In 1984 she led the Olympic team to gold scoring better than 16 points per game. Her superior athletic ability and engaging persona placed her among the elite in the world of college and professional athletics. In 1986, Sports Illustrated named Miller as the best male or female player in college basketball. In a spectacular career, Miller scored 3,018 total career points and was a four-time All-America. Miller was named Naismith Player of the Year three times and earned the Wade Trophy once.

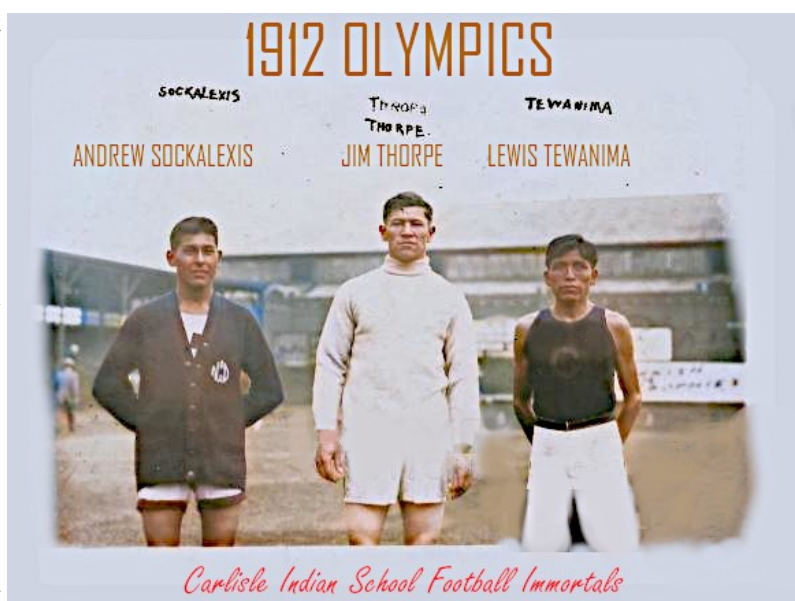
Miller was asked about what she wanted impart upon the two rookies that will follow them beyond the All-Star game.

## 1964 Billy Mills Wins Gold 10,000 METERS \* FAST FORWARD 60-Years:

2024 Bill Mills is the only American & American Indian to ever Win the Olympic Games 10,000 meter

"Who are you?" an official asked Mills after his stunning win. "A Lakota boy from Pine Ridge," he replied, a moment that still resonates with pride and inspiration. Mills went on to co-found the nonprofit Running Strong for American Indian Youth and received honors such as the Presidential Citizens Medal and the Theodore Roosevelt Award by the NCAA.

In a moment that left the world in awe, an American Indian from the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation in South Dakota, Billy Mills, charged down the track at the Tokyo 1964 Olympic Games to win the 10,000-meter run. It was one of the greatest upsets in Olympic history, and over 60 years later, it remains a powerful tale of perseverance and triumph.

Mills, a member of the Oglala Lakota tribe, faced immense challenges from a young age. Orphaned by the age of 12, he attended the Haskell Institute, a boarding school for Na-

tive Americans, where he discovered his passion for running. His talent took him to the University of Kansas, where he became a three-time All-American in cross-country.

Despite qualifying for the Olympics, Mills wasn't expected to win. His times lagged nearly a minute behind the world record-holder, Ron Clarke of Australia. Adding to the challenge, Mills managed his Type 2 diabetes during the grueling race. But on that unforgettable day, he defied all expectations, sprinting ahead in the final moments to claim victory with an Olympic record time, nearly 50 seconds faster than his personal best.

"A true story of overcoming adversity, Billy Mills' victory is not just a sports achievement but a beacon of hope and inspiration for generations.

In July, Mills was the keynote speaker at the Tribal Youth Conference in Palms Springs which my great-grandson attended. He was on cloud 9 when he came home. Go Billy!

### Border politics

Vice President Kamala Harris and her team rushed to scrub her record on the largest, most public job she was given in the Biden-Harris administration. As soon as President Joe Biden acknowledged the political reality that he couldn't beat former President Donald Trump and anointed Harris his successor, the first thing that had to go were mentions of her work as the administration's "border czar."

The title was, in fact, never an official one. Journalists used it as shorthand for the incredibly difficult task Harris was given of addressing the "root causes" of the massive surge in migration from South American countries to the U.S. southern border. Biden and Harris leapfrogged the handful of Trump-era policies the president reversed on Day One, including chipping away at the popular and effective "Remain in Mexico" plan that required migrants to try to seek asylum in countries they encountered before reaching the United States.

A PR campaign of epic proportions has played out in the last two weeks, with media outlets scrubbing their own reporting and commentary that referred to Harris as the "border czar," insisting she was never given responsibility for the border and was only involved in diplomacy efforts. The reversal has been at the center of a campaign by Republicans to define Harris in the eyes of voters who have just fewer than 100 days before Election Day. In part four of the *Washington Examiner's* series exploring the race to define Harris, Immigration Reporter Anna Giaritelli dug through the vice presi-

dent's record on the border to see exactly what is on the table.

Besides the tussle over what Harris's designation and responsibilities regarding the border for the last 3 1/2 years were, it's clear she has bobbed and weaved her way through a minefield of thorny situations.

### Democratic doubts muddy Supreme Court suspicion

*"Despite the low likelihood that Biden's Supreme Court reforms will garner support in a sharply divided Congress, polling data released from Gallup this week reveal the public's negative sentiment against the Supreme Court's work is anchored by Democratic respondents, not by independents and Republicans,"* he wrote.

Biden opened the week with an announcement he was going to push forward with plans to overhaul the court that Democrats have been begging to see for years. He stopped shy of calling for an outright court-packing situation — a historically unpopular idea that tarnished even the record of Franklin Delano Roosevelt. What he did demand was to see a constitutional amendment that would gut the court's decision on presidential immunity, an enforceable ethics code, and 18-year term limits for justices.

All three propositions have no clear path to success, and their varying levels of support are mostly buoyed by frustrated Democrats desperate to pick a fight with the 6-3 Republican-appointed justice majority.

Jonathan Turley, a professor at George Washington University Law School, told Kaelan he

believes *the "polling shows that the response to President Biden's 'reforms' has been the sound of one hand clapping."*

### Back to school on Title IX

Biden has rolled back the Trump-era changes, and a return of shady campus courtroom trials is spooking legal experts who are warning the changes are set to cause more harm than good. Investigative Reporter Breccan Thies took a look at what the new Title IX system, which goes into effect on several campuses today, will look like.

*"President Joe Biden's rules have been blocked by federal judges across the country, pausing their implementation in numerous states and hundreds of schools, with more cases pending. But for far more states and schools, the rewritten rules go into effect Aug. 1, and how schools approach handling sexual assault allegations will be dramatically changed,"* Breccan wrote.

*"While most of the court cases and media coverage about Biden's Title IX rewrite has focused on how it changed the definition of sex to include claimed gender identities — thereby shuttering private spaces for girls and boys to use restrooms and locker rooms separately, for example — the new rules also strip away many major due process protections for alleged Title IX violations on college campuses and diminish the presumption of innocence for the accused."*

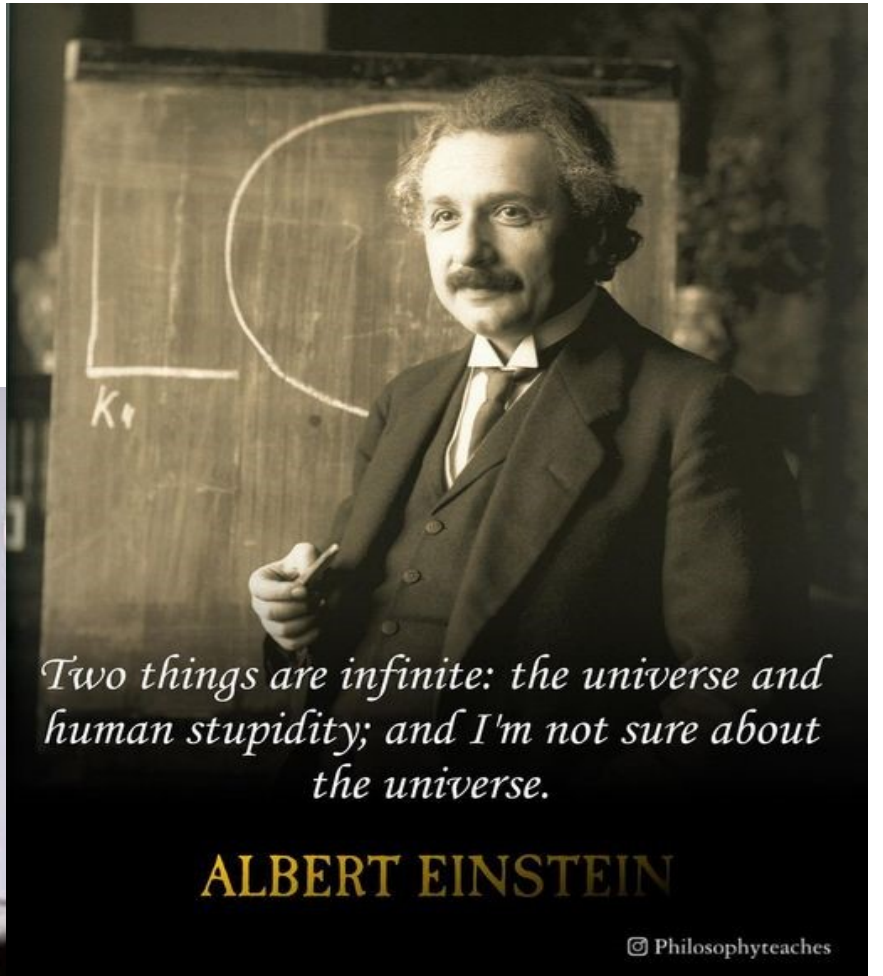

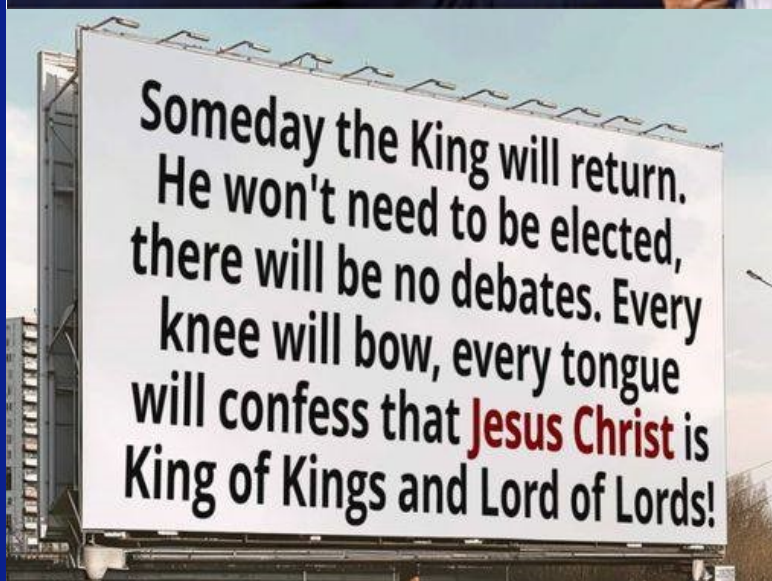

*"No, not a memorial or statue,"* the woman interjected hastily. *"We wish to build a new building for Harvard."*

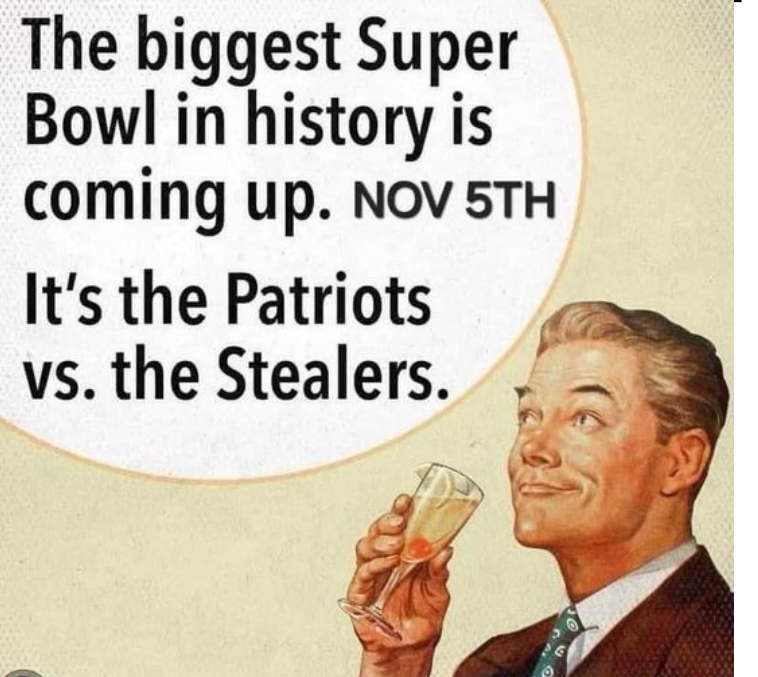
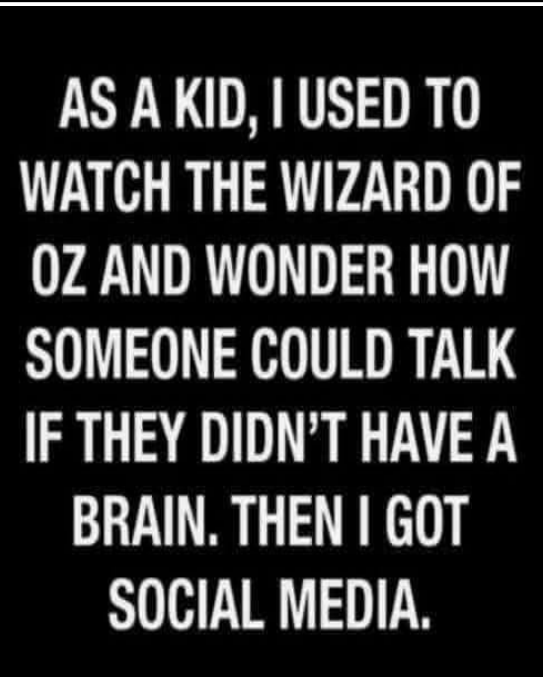
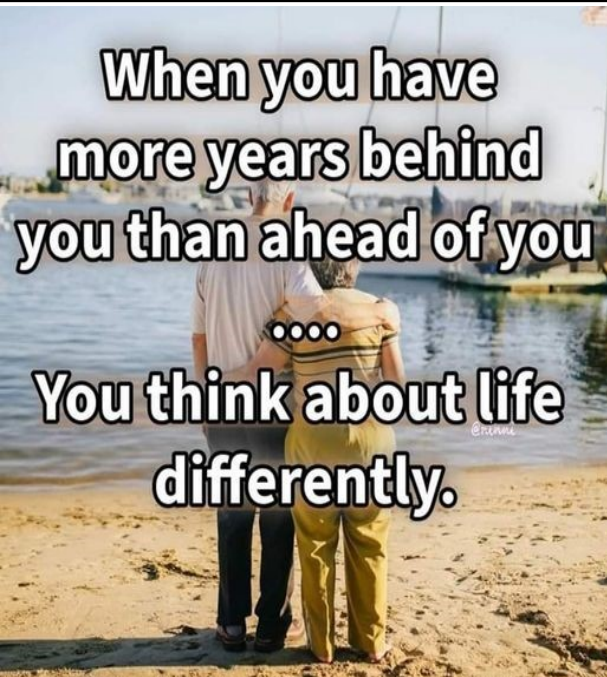
The director scoffed, noting their modest attire, *"Do you have any idea how much that would cost? Our buildings are valued at over seven million dollars."*
