A few Tribal Organizations come mine that could take the leadership as proposed. First, the National Congress of American Indians which is a national group, but appears to be more focused on their internal power structure than real Tribal issues.

The other Tribal Organization that could make thing happen is the California Tribal Chairpersons Association, Inc., under the **leadership of Bo Mazzetti**, who also serves as the Tribal Chairman of the Rincon Band of
