Judge tosses Biden administration's Title IX rewrite that conferred protections based on gender identity

A federal judge struck down a sweeping Title IX expansion for gender-confused individuals and other sexual behavior, the Associated Press reported. U.S. District Judge Danny C. Reeves' decision Thursday negated the entire 1,500-page guideline he called "fatally" flawed.

President Joe Biden's administration was behind the push to confer Title IX protections on so-called LGBTQ⁺ students last year. The law was initially passed in 1972, and it was done to prevent sex discrimination in education.

The Democratic administration made it their business to expand the definitions of those covered, including protections for sexual orientation and gender identity instead of biological sex.

Because of this, the update faced many challenges from those concerned about its impact on the safety of girls and women. This lawsuit resolved this week was filed by the attorneys general of Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, Tennesee, Virginia, and West Virginia.


Revees concluded in his decision that the Department of Education had no authority to make the changes through the 50-year-old law. The judge called it an "attempt to bypass the legislative process and completely transform Title IX."

One specific issue was that it violated free speech by compelling educators to use preferred pronouns. "The First Amendment does not permit the government to chill speech or compel affirmance of a belief with which the speaker disagrees in this manner," Reeves wrote in his decision.



Tribes, including the Hoopa, Karuk, Klamath, Modoc and Yurok, thrived in this bountiful and beautiful watershed for thousands of years, with the river providing both sustenance and ritual.



Nikola Tesla registered more than 700 patents in 35 countries of the world, and many of those inventions brought progress and prosperity to mankind.

However, Tesla, when he died in New York, was penniless, and if he wanted money he would be one of the richest in the world.

Nikola Tesla 1st Electric Car in 1918 That Regenerate Electricity from the Earth.

This is Nikola Tesla's 1921 Pierce-Arrow electric car, powered by pure etheric electricity. It is a self-charging car; it does not run on batteries, oil, or gas. Electric cars have been around much

In 1931, Nikola Tesla presented and tested a new automobile. Tesla had developed it with his own personal funds.

The motor had been removed, leaving the clutch, gearbox and transmission to the rear wheels uninterrupted. The power receiver (gravity energy converter) had been built by Tesla himself. It was installed in front of the control panel. A heavy antenna, approximately 1.8 meters long, protruded from the converter. This antenna apparently had the function as that of the moray converter (radiant energy!).

"Now we have power," said Tesla? he said there was enough power in the converter to light an entire house, plus run the car's motor. The car was tested for a week, reaching a top speed of 144 km per hour effortlessly. Someone commented that no gases were coming out of the tailpipe. Nikola Tesla replied, "We have no motor."

Shayne's Journal * The "Five W's" of Journalism

The "Five W's" of Journalism who, what, where, why, and how - can be, and should be, a way to develop, nurture and instill critical thinking skills in those around you For those that have an organized classroom or regularly meeting teen group here is a suggested format. Have your students empty their purses or pockets on their desk table. Pick out an item. Put it through the questions: 1. Who (what) is this? 2. What does it do? 3. Where did it come from? How did it get here? 4. Why is it important? 5. How is it made? Once the student has chosen their item, they are to recount their existing knowledge about the item and then do formal research paper (two pages) on the item which answers all the 5 w's in greater depth. This all goes into a formally documented report which is then delivered to the group. Imagine the amount of knowledge one can gain in one afternoon! Developing the prowess to constantly think the 5 w's will give learners the ability to assess almost anything they view. Skipping up one notch Taking it to the next level, ask the students
