Conservative CNN pundit Scott Jennings ripped liberal Supreme Court Justice Elena Kagan as a partisan hack for opposing the elimination of nationwide injunctions – despite wanting to end the practice when President Biden was in power.

Jennings called out Kagan – one of three dissenters in Friday’s historic Supreme Court ruling that prevents district court judges from interfering with a president’s agenda – for previously and publicly slamming the widespread abuse of nationwide injunctions during a Democratic presidency.

The political and ideological violence that has exploded in Los Angeles and elsewhere in America over the past weeks has little to do with the issue of illegal immigrants. The goal, rather, was to exploit this issue for the emotion that is needed to grow a crowd into a national mass movement. The aim here has nothing to do with immigration reform but everything to do with the total and unrepentant dismantling of America.

We have been here before. Over and over.

From 2012 to 2020, it was the Black people, especially those in my community, who were mercilessly exploited by the same radicals to advance their causes. We had riots after the deaths of Trayvon Martin, Michael Brown, and the granddaddy of them all, George Floyd and they were done in the name of social justice.

They screamed "Black Lives Matter!" They made speeches on systemic racism, White privilege, mass incarceration, Black bodies and on. It was pure spectacle.

Yet, this political and ideological violence, especially after Floyd’s death, manifested itself physically in the destruction of my already impoverished neighborhood on the South Side of Chicago.

Yet these protests destroyed my already impover-

ished neighborhood even further. I had to arrange for senior citizens to get rides to pharmacies in the suburbs for their medicine. I organized crews to sweep up the glass from broken windows in the nearby shops. I had food brought in to make sure no one went hungry, since some were afraid to come out of their homes.

Meanwhile, the leaders of those protests raked in so much money. It was like the Niagara Falls of White guilt money. They said all that money would go to Blacks on the ground.

Instead, it went to Black Lives Matter mansions, White liberal women preaching about White fragility, elite Black professors pushing antiracism, non-profits promising us the magic pill of diversity, teachers’ unions promising they will lift the most disadvantaged among us not with hard work but equity and on and on.

Not one single penny came into my neighborhood – not that I ever wanted "Black pain" money. It was the biggest scam I have ever seen in my life.

America has been paying the price ever since. It is stunning for me to watch wealthy American neighborhoods like the ones in the Bay Area fight over race and ethnic studies in their schools – again, all done in the name of those in my neighborhood. It



simply stuns me that they believe the best way to help us is to remove honors classes and lower standards across the board.

But what good is an uneducated or undereducated mind to America?

Then again, that is the objective of those who commit political and ideological violence in the American streets. Liberalism – not racism – destroyed my neighborhood and created generations of impoverished people who don’t know a life without some sort of dependency on the government. 'A huge victory': Christian leaders react to Supreme Court's Skrmetti ruling

Advocacy groups on both sides of the aisle are reacting after the U.S. Supreme Court upheld a Tennessee law banning youth with gender dysphoria from obtaining life-altering surgeries and hormone drugs.

The nation's highest court ruled 6-3 Wednesday in *Skrmetti v. United States* that Tennessee's ban on so-called gender transition procedures for minors does not violate the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

The ruling, which points to concerns being raised about such experimental medical procedures by foreign governments, as it justifies the state government's motive to regulate, sets a judicial precedent that enables the law and others like it across the U.S. to remain in effect.

While Christian conservative legal organizations and advocacy groups reacted favorably to this development, some progressive faith organizations, as well as advocacy groups that promote strict separation of church and state, claim the ruling could shut down "Healthcare for Transgender Youth in 27 States."

Non-Citizen Voting Ban Passes — 148 Democrats Voted No

The House of Representatives has approved a bill on June 10 to pull back a Washington, D.C., law allowing non-citizens to vote in local elections. The vote was 266-148, with 56 Democrats joining Republicans in support. The legislation forms part of a broader Republican effort to reassert control over D.C. laws. **One Democrat voted "present."** The vote highlighted a partisan split with Democrats arguing it undermines D.C.'s autonomy. Democrats say noncitizen voting is valid in some local contexts. Republicans emphasized the safeguarding of election integrity by restricting voting to U.S. citizens.

The voting results have drawn criticism toward the 148 Democratic lawmakers who rejected the legislation. Rep. August Pfluger (R-TX) criticized the overturned law as conflicting with national standards.

Pfluger said, *"D.C.'s City Council made radical decisions in our nation's capital under the Biden-Harris administration, passing local laws that are woefully inconsistent with national standards or constitutional principles."*

Schumer Thinks Anti-ICE Nonprofit Bankrolled By China Needs More American Tax Dollars

Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer is seeking over half a million in taxpayer funds for a New York City nonprofit group under congressional investigation for allegedly coaching people how to avoid Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) apprehension.

In a formal request letter to a Senate Appropriations subcommittee, Schumer requested a total of \$600,000 for the Chinese-American Planning Council (CPC). The liberal nonprofit group has been under public fire since a Daily Caller News Foundation investigation uncovered large sums of Chinese government-connected cash flowing to the group and its connection to an organization accused of promoting Chinese Communist Party interests.

In April, the Oversight Project — an investigative group formerly connected with the Heritage Foundation — released video footage appearing to show a CPC employee coaching audience members on best practices to avoid ICE apprehension during a seminar. Carlyn Cowen, the CPC's chief policy and public affairs officer, was filmed explaining several tips to an audience on how to avoid federal immigration officials, such as *"hardening your physical space"* and *"identifying a list of individuals authorized to respond if ICE comes to the door."*

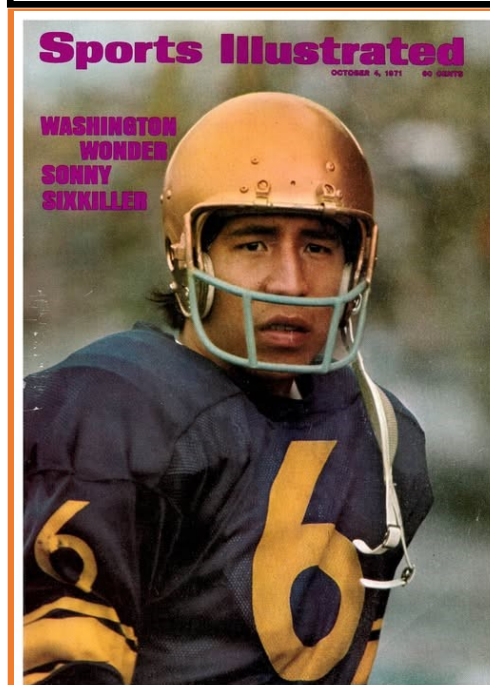

Sonny Sixkiller, an American Indian Cherokee Nation tribal member

Sonny Sixkiller, an American Indian professional football player, quarterback position, is a Cherokee Nation tribal member. He was born in Tahlequah, Oklahoma on September 6, 1951. His family moved to Ashland, Oregon, when he was about one year old.

Young Sonny attended Ashland High School in Ashland, Oregon, and wanted to play in-state college football for Oregon State, but they didn't offer him a scholarship (it's been said) because of his small size for professional football: 5'11" and 171 lbs.

However, Sixkiller did receive a scholarship to the University of Washington in Seattle. As a sophomore in 1970, he became the starting quarterback for the Washington Huskies and led the NCAA in passing. Sonny Sixkiller was a

stand-out athlete and held some fifteen school athletic records. In just 28 games (1970-1972), Sonny Sixkiller became one of the most popular players in Washington University athletic history.

Solar company accused of taking prehistoric artifacts from California land

For years, California has touted itself as America's green energy champion. Launching initiatives to fund renewable energy projects for disadvantaged communities and investing tens of millions of dollars in cutting-edge solar panels, the state is slowly working toward ,

According to a 2025 study called "Sex for solar? Examining patterns of public and private sector corruption within the booming California solar

energy market," Boston University researchers identified several patterns of corruption within the state's renewable energy industry from 2010 to 2024. Study participants throughout South-eastern California accused the lobbyist for one project in particular, Genesis, of exchanging "sexual services" for "solar favoritism," the paper continues.

In 2011, a Department of Interior official and aide to former Interior Secretary Ken Salazar was reportedly dating a lobbyist for NextEra, the company that owned the Genesis Solar Energy Project, the study says. According to a DOI investigation published in 2014, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service agents notified authorities of the official's relationship in March 2013. Two months later, the official resigned, the report shows.

And according to a lawsuit that the Colorado River Indian Tribes filed against the Bureau of Land Management in 2014, Genesis found hundreds of Indigenous tools, along with a stone pendant and possible cremation site, without properly notifying members. This mass disturbance, legal documents said, caused the local Native American community "substantial emotional, spiritual, and even physical pain."



New radiocarbon dating confirms humans in North America 23,000 years ago

confirmed that humans were present in North America approximately 10,000 years earlier than previously believed. The footprints, dated to between 23,000 and 21,000 years old, provide evidence that humans occupied the area much earlier than the Clovis culture, which was long considered the oldest in North America.

Researchers initially dated the footprints using seeds and pollen, but critics argued these were unreliable markers. The new study relies on dating the ancient mud in which the footprints were found, providing a third method that supports the earlier findings. Three separate, independent labs conducted the dating, resulting in 55 consistent radiocarbon dates. The research was published in the scientific journal Science Advances.

"It's a remarkably consistent record. You get to the point where it's really hard to explain all this away," said Vance Holliday, a professor emeritus at the University of Arizona. *"It would be serendipity in the extreme to have all these dates giving you a consistent picture that's in error,"* he added.

The discovery of these older footprints has implications for understanding human migration to the Americas. The footprints provide evidence that human activity in the area occurred between 23,000 and 21,000 years ago, making them about 10,000 years older than remains found 90 years ago at a site near Clovis, New Mexico. The Clovis site gave its name to an artifact assemblage long understood by archaeologists to represent the earliest known culture in North America.

‘Invading is just easier than waiting in line’: Gutfeld tells how Democrats ‘screwed over’ millions of legal migrants

Fox News’ Greg Gutfeld tore into Democrats Tuesday (June 17, 2025) on “The Five” for having “screwed over” millions of legal migrants due to their adamant support of illegal immigrants. Biden’s DEI Marxist, Justice Ketanji Brown Jackson Slams Supreme Court For Not Voting Her Way as ‘Narrow-Minded’ in Recent 7-2 Voting

Once again, contributing to the theory that she is a certified “**Mouth Breather**” Justice Ketanji Brown Jackson in a series of sharp dissents, accused her Supreme Court colleagues of issuing rulings that appear to favor financial interests over their sworn duty, according to *ABC News*. Brown Jackson’s criticism follows several rulings in controversial cases.

For the *Stanley v. City of Sanford* case, a retired Florida firefighter fighting Parkinson’s disease attempted to sue the city, which employed her, under the Americans with Disabilities Act after terminating its extended health insurance coverage for retirees who left the force before serving 25 years due to disability.

The scathing comments came after the Supreme Court heard arguments in the *Diamond Alternative Energy v. EPA* (Environmental Protection Agency) case, ruling 7-2 in favor of fuel producers attempting to challenge the EPA’s approval of California clean vehicle emissions regulations.

In 1911, a starving man emerged from the wilderness near Oroville, California, marking the end of an era. He was the last known member of the Yahi, a subgroup of the Yana people who had once thrived in the region before being decimated by settler violence, disease, and displacement during the California Gold Rush. Unable to live in seclusion any longer, he was taken in by anthropologists at the University of California, Berkeley. When asked his name, he replied that he had none—Yahi tradition held that one could not speak their own name unless formally introduced by another member of their tribe. With no other Yahi left to do so, he simply became *“the man with no name.”*

The anthropologists, recognizing the cultural weight of this, gave him the name **“Ishi,”** which means **“man”** in the Yana language. Ishi spent the remainder of his life in San Francisco, working at the university’s museum, where he demonstrated traditional Yahi crafts and shared what knowledge he could of his people’s language and way of life. His presence was both a rare ethnographic opportunity and a tragic reminder of the genocide inflicted upon Native peoples in the United States. To this day, Ishi is remembered not just as the **“last wild Indian”**—a term he was often labeled with—but as a symbol of cultural survival, dignity, and the devastating cost of colonization.

Autumn has spoken to world leaders, been honoured by the Assembly of First Nations, was the Keynote speaker at the United Nations World Water Day, traveled the world to raise awareness, and has been nominated for the prestigious International Children’s Peace Prize in 2017, 2018 and 2019, as well as being named a “Science Defender” by the Union of Concerned Scientists in 2019.

A Pleasant Childhood Rez Memory

MY VIEW Ernie C. Salgado Jr., Mae Razon (maiden name), is pictured in the photo on the right.

I found the photo of Mae posted on Facebook by her daughter Mary Maxine Resvaloso and it brought back some pleasing memories from my childhood on the Soboba Indian Reservation in So. Calif.

I believe Mae to be the oldest of the eight children of John Razon (Torres Martinez Rez) and Clemencia AKA Clementine Silvas (Soboba Rez.)

Although Mae was 10 to 12 years older than I, my memories of her kindness, gentleness and ear to ear smile still touch my heart.

Mae married a guy named Lester, don’t recall his last name and they moved to the Indio desert area and would visit her family regularly on the Soboba Rez.

I grew up with her brother **“Cake”** (John Razon III) who was a year older than me and as tough as they come. He showed up one day wearing a football helmet made out of cardboard and string. He was so proud of his homemade helmet because Lester had made it for him. Well, needless to say, without a single word or a mere glance between us, on the first play of the game we all gang tackled **“Cake”** and rip his helmet to pieces. He was so mad and crying as he left we were all laughing and teasing him telling him to ask Lester to make him another one. But, he was back the next day with a vengeance. And, Lester did make him another cardboard helmet that he would wear around his home.

In retrospect, I’d have to admit that we were a pretty rough & wild bunch of kids on the Rez during the late 40’s and early 50’s. We played baseball, full tackle football without pads on hard dirt and fighting as we were playing hockey. **“King of the Hill”** was another game of controlled violence we played. Again, as I look back at my formative years the Machiavellian principles appear to be a dominating factor in my early life; *It’s better to be feared than loved, the end justifies the means and reputation.*

As time passed Mae’s visits became less frequent. I don’t remember the last time I saw or spoke to her but, I still remember her tenderness and kindness these 70 plus years later as a beautiful loving Rez lady.

I believe in God, & that he speaks to us in countless modes, one of which is through his angels that often takes years for us to understand his message. God Bless!

Billy Mills Happy Birthday & 1964 Olympics 10K Gold

In the 1964 Tokyo Olympics, nobody expected a Native American runner from Pine Ridge, South Dakota to make history. His name was Billy Mills, a member of the Oglala Lakota Nation, and he entered the 10,000-meter race. (Birthday June 30, 1938.)

The field was packed with giants: world-record holder Ron Clarke of Australia, Tunisia's Mohammed Gammoudi, and Ethiopia's Mamo Wolde. Billy Mills? He wasn't on anyone's radar. Not the media. But from the very first lap, Mills hung in. As others dropped off, he stayed. And with just one lap to go, chaos erupted. Clarke tried to break free of traffic and collided with Mills. Gammoudi surged ahead. Mills looked boxed out, his chances fading fast.



Then, something extraordinary happened. Billy Mills found a second wind—no, a third. He shifted wide to lane four and unleashed a final sprint that no one saw coming. He passed Clarke. He passed Gammoudi. And he crossed the finish line first in 28:24.4, an Olympic record—nearly 50 seconds faster than he had ever run before.

The stadium froze. The world froze. And then came the call from NBC: **"Look at Mills! Look at Mills!"**

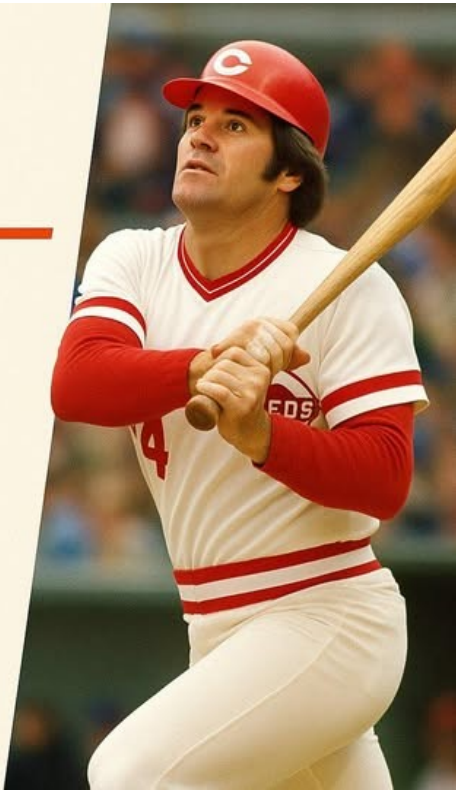

We miss you but, know you’re in good company. Love you always!

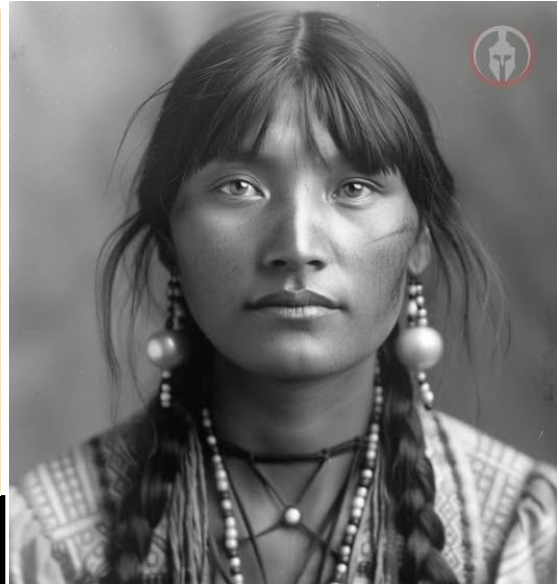
