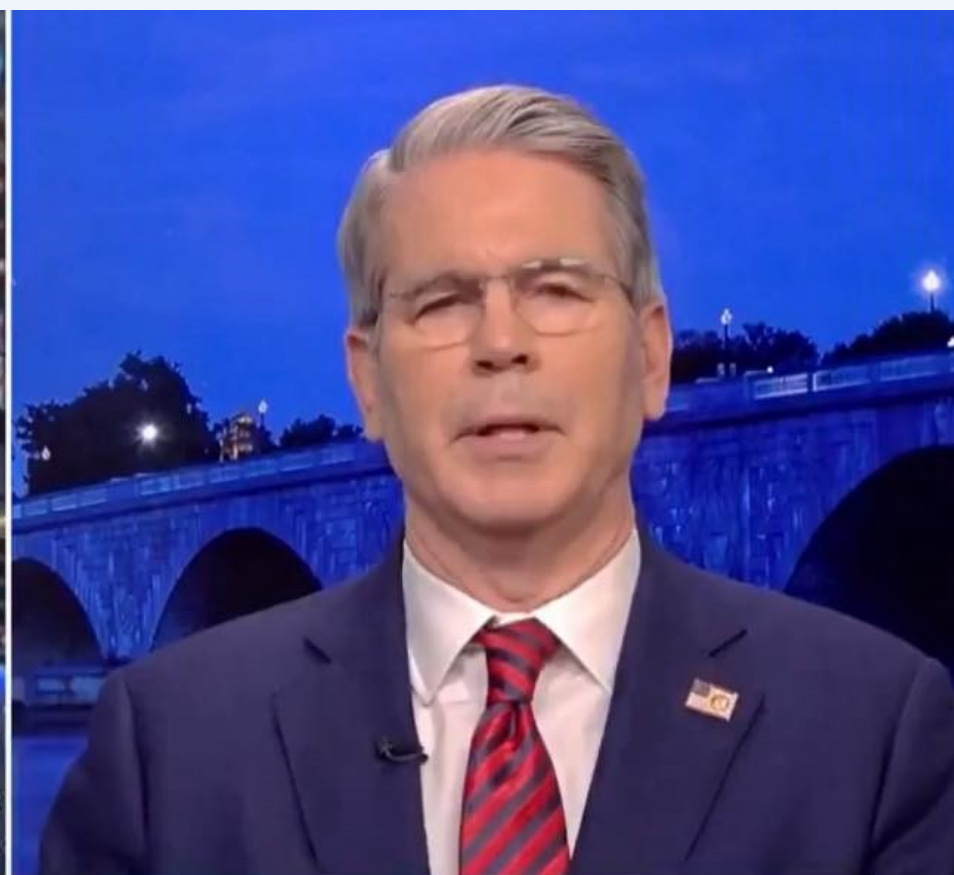

Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent gives his defense in the “Tonight Show” with Rob Schmitt of the Congressional spending bill - *“I’m a fiscal hawk, but I’m also a realist.”* Treasury Secretary Bessent said.

“The way to think about this is every \$300 billion is 1% of GDP...we have to bring this down gradually because we want to do two things. We want to cut and constrain spending, and we want to grow the economy.”

“What Senator Paul is asking for could cause a sudden stop in the economy. So I’m a deficit hawk, but I’m also a realist.”

“What’s important here is our debt-to-GDP. If we don’t grow, then we won’t grow the tax base and we’re not going to grow revenues. We’re not going to grow the economy.”

“We inherited a mess and we have to constrain spending, cut spending, and then grow our way out of this.”

The tax measure would also extend tax cuts from Trump’s first term that are to expire on Dec. 31, along with new tax relief, including temporarily exempting tips and overtime pay from taxes.

Seven times federal judges ruled against the Trump admin this week (June 1-7, 2025)

Federal judges are continuing their pushback against the Trump administration by issuing orders blocking a number of actions, including the deportation of the family of Mohamed Soliman, who is facing a hate crime charge in the wake of a firebombing attack in Colorado.

The rulings – some from judges appointed under the Biden administration – come after White House Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt said last week that *“President Trump had more injunctions in one full month of office in February than Joe Biden had in three years.”*

“The real constitutional crisis is taking place within our judicial branch, where district court judges in liberal districts across the country are abusing their power to unilaterally block President Trump’s basic executive authority,” Leavitt also has said.

A federal judge on Wednesday (June 4, 2025) issued a temporary restraining order that stops the Trump administration from closing Job Corps centers.

Separately on Wednesday, (June 4, 2025) U.S. District Judge Paula Xinis granted a request from Abrego Garcia’s legal team to file a motion for sanctions against the Trump administration.

How Well-Funded, Organized Leftists Helped Jumpstart LA Riots

Well-funded activists and a coordinated social media campaign helped spark the pro-illegal migrant protests on Friday that descended into days of rioting in Los Angeles.

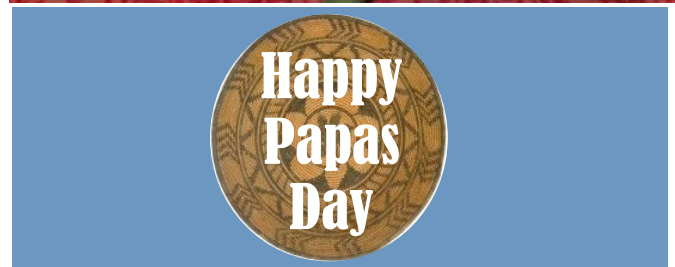
Left-wing groups posted calls to action with a location to gather on Friday in unison after the arrest of a local Service Employees International Union (SEIU) leader on Friday. The subsequent uprising echoed scenes of the Black Lives Matter riots of 2020, which brought activists such as professional “legal observers” into the streets during a wave of protests that led to fires, looting, vandalism and deaths across the country as the organization’s leaders enriched themselves.

Protests continued in a coordinated fashion through Monday, with some unidentified individuals driving up to others in trucks to distribute protective face shields resembling gas masks, according to a Fox 11 reporter who said he witnessed the trend. Fox News’ Bill Melugin reported on Sunday that protesters were being provided with ear plugs, gas masks and water bottles that they then hurled at police officers.

“The FBI is investigating any and all monetary connections responsible for these riots,” FBI Director Kash Patel said Monday night.

As the chaos built up, activist groups — and a major labor union — fanned the flames of the anti-ICE movement by fomenting resistance to law enforcement in the streets and online.

It's not the first time Waters, who has served in Congress since 1991, has faced ethical financial problems. In 2004, Waters arranged for her daughter to work on her campaign as a slate mailer — an uncommon practice on the federal level, but typical within California politics — providing her daughter with over \$1.2 million in payments since, which many allege to be campaign finance malpractice.

The House Ethics Committee also formally accused Waters of violating conflict of interest rules in 2010, claiming she was giving government help to a bank with ties to her husband. The Committee eventually dismissed the case but Waters' chief of staff was reprimanded.

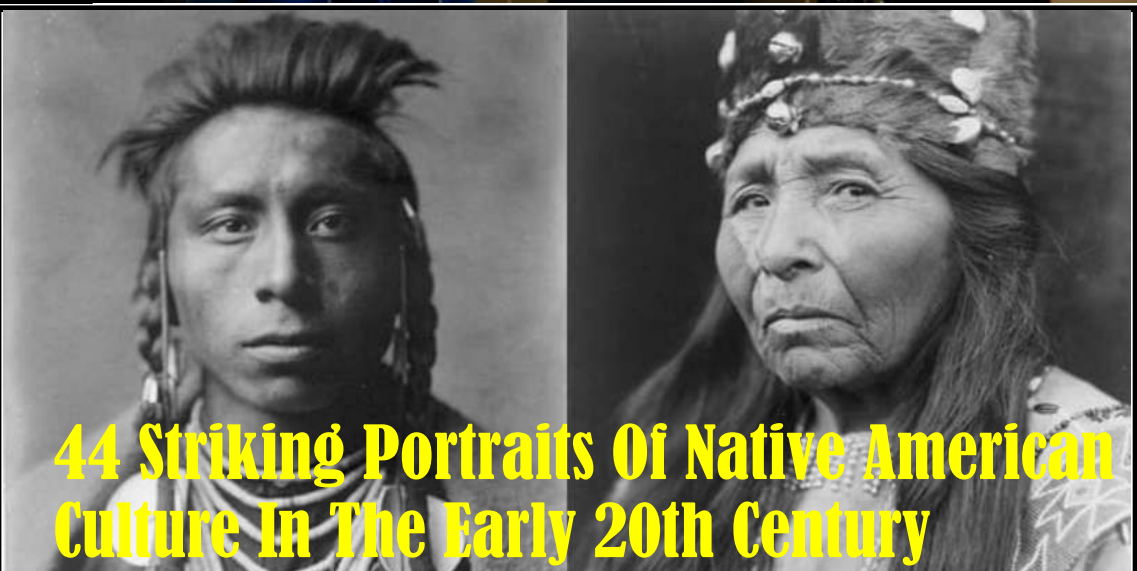

Ancient DNA confirms Picuris Pueblo’s ancestral link to Chaco Canyon

The Picuris, an Indigenous group of only around 300 members today, have preserved oral histories linking them to Chaco Canyon — a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its vast desert landscape and unique sandstone structures — for centuries. However, the stories were dismissed and excluded by scholars and policymakers. Seeking a louder voice in deci-

sions about the region, particularly as the debate over oil and gas drilling continues, tribal leaders turned to science to confirm their historical narratives... In a milestone study published in Nature on April 30, 2025 northern New Mexico’s Picuris Pueblo has, for the first time, led a genetic study confirming their

ancestral connection to the famous Chaco Canyon — a monumental site central to Pueblo culture. This collaboration with international geneticists represents a significant shift in the methods of scientific research involving Indigenous communities, placing Native voices at the forefront.

California sheriff warns of cartels amid accusations of overstepping authority in tribal land cannabis raids

A Northern California sheriff is speaking out after a Native American tribe accused him of overstepping his authority when his office conducted raids on cannabis farms on tribal land last year amid his warning that drug cartel organizations had a "toehold" in the area. Mendocino County Sheriff Matthew Kendall told Fox News Digital his office has received pleas from tribal members asking for action to combat illegal cannabis farms as well as crime on the reservation. Kendall said most of his office's raids were not on tribal land. *"They're begging me, saying, 'Please, we've got gunshots going on all night, all around us,'"* he said. *"These people are tribal members as well as people who aren't tribal members. I have to go up and protect these folks. I have to go up and deal with the law. But when I go up there and*

serve search warrants and what-not, and next thing you know, I'm getting sued for it." *"It's a very depressed economy, and it's kind of ripe for picking for bad things to come in,"* he said of the cartels. *"We've had a lot of shootings up there, a lot of violence up there. It's not OK, the things that are going on."* The Round Valley Indian Tribes and three individual plaintiffs, April James, 48, Eunice Swearingen, 86, and Steve Britton, are asking a federal court to impose an injunction to prevent the sheriff's department from carrying out more raids on their land. Round Valley, which is surrounded by mountains, is now rife with illicit cannabis and cartel activity as well as murders, Kendall said.

Trump Cheers Court After Whiplash Appeal Restores His National Guard Control: ‘We Saved L.A.!’

President **Donald Trump** celebrated a federal appeals court ruling Thursday that granted him a temporary legal victory in his use of military force on U.S. soil, allowing the National Guard to remain deployed and under his control in Los Angeles as immigration protests stretch into their second week.

The decision, handed down Thursday night by the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals, paused [an earlier ruling](#) by U.S. District Judge **Charles Breyer**, who found the president’s deployment unlawful and ordered control of the Guard returned to California Gov. **Gavin Newsom**.

The legal whiplash, pausing Breyer’s 36-page rebuke just two hours after it dropped, left Los Angeles caught between two clashing branches of government and a national debate over presidential power, immigration enforcement, and military presence in civilian life.

Biden reportedly only hand-signed one pardon – guess who it was?

Over four years, President Biden issued 80 pardons and 4,165 commutations for a total of 4,245 acts of clemency, the total being more than any president in the 20th century, according to Pew Research.

With the Trump administration investigating the circumstances behind the Biden administration’s heavy reliance on the presidential autopen, turns out **the only hand-signed pardon during Biden’s final months in office was for his son, Hunter.**

The former president granted clemency to more than 1,500 individuals in his final weeks in office, the largest single-day act of clemency in US history.

Biden did not hand-sign preemptive pardons that came in the final days of his presidency for other family members, Dr. Anthony Fauci, Gen. Mark Milley and members and staff of the House committee investigating Jan. 6.

The blanket pardon for Hunter covers any offenses against the U.S. that he **“has committed or may have committed”** from Jan. 1, 2014, to Dec. 1, 2024, and came after Biden vowed not to **“interfere.”**

Fox Business Evening Edit anchor Elizabeth MacDonald cited the Heritage Foundation to report that the autopen was used for **“nearly all executive actions and official documents.”**

I didn’t realize all this happened in 2015. Of course, no one read the bill.

Here is what happened, quietly, on January 1, 2015:

- Medicare tax went from 1.45% to 2.35%
- Top Income tax bracket went from 35% to 39.6%
- Top Income payroll tax went from 37.4% to 52.2%
- Capital Gains tax went from 15% to 28%
- Dividend tax went from 15% to 39.6%
- Estate tax went from 0% to 55%
- A 3.5% Real Estate transaction tax was added.

Teacher Calls For Change After Seeing An Enormous Drop In The Involvement Of Parents In Her Students' Lives. * By Kate Woodberry

"As parents, our job is to grow the most amazing humans possible."

Every year, middle school teacher Amie Diprima Brown of Rome, Georgia, sends a letter to parents on the first day of school asking them to describe their child.

Amie has been doing this for the past 15 years and has found the task to be hugely beneficial in her role as teacher, but in recent times she has been shocked to see the response rate from parents drop drastically.

In 2003, 98% of parents completed the task. In 2017, the response rate had fallen to just 22%, leading to Amie writing a thought-provoking Facebook post urging parents to be more involved in their children's lives.

"With all of the talk about guns in schools, why it's happening, and how to solve the issue let me offer a little different perspective. I've been teaching since 2003. This marks my 15th year in the classroom. Everybody always talks about how schools have changed, and it's true, they have. Yes, there's the 'crazy new math' and 'bring your own device' changes. However, there are some other changes that I think the general population is not aware of.

Every year for 15 years I have sent home the same assignment on the first day of school. I send a letter home asking parents to tell me about their child in a million words or less. I go on to

explain that I want to learn the child's hopes, dreams, fears, challenges, etc and jokingly ask parents to limit it to less than a million words since we all know we could talk forever about our children. I go on to say I'm not grading these, not looking at handwriting or grammar and don't care if they send them back with their child, email them, drop them off at the office, etc. These letters have been so beneficial to me as a teacher and getting to know my students on a personal level. I have learned about eating disorders, seizures, jealousy issues between twins, depression, adoption, abuse...just to name a few things. These letters give me a huge head start on getting to truly know my students. I often pull them out when a child has a sudden change in behavior or issue that comes up. Just this week I had 2 students lose their mother unexpectedly. Brother and sister, I taught one last year and one this year. As I have done before, I immediately went to my folders to pull the letters that mom sent for her children. It's a beautiful gift that I feel I can give students to get a glimpse into how much a parent loved and adored them. As I was putting the folders back in the file cabinet I noticed something. I know that the percentage of parents that complete this assignment each year has got-

ten lower and lower, but looking at the size of the folders shocked me. That first year I had 98% of the parents send back some type of letter on their child. This year... 22%. That's a lot of opportunities lost for me to get to know students. Sadly, more parents have access to an electronic device that makes this task even easier and less time consuming.

On another note, this year's average for homework turned in is riding at 67%. I'm talking a twice monthly 5 sentence summary of what the student is reading in their own time. I remind students daily, I send text messages through Remind, it's on my website. The only other thing I could do is do it for them. Parents continue to let their child rack up zero after zero. But then again, that average used to be around 98% as well. It was rare for more than 1-2 students to not have their homework 15 years ago. Now, it's just frustrating.

With all of our other responsibilities in our profession, how are we supposed to get to know students so that we can identify the ones with the mentality and disposition to become a school shooter if parents are checking out of the academic process? How are we supposed to educate children when their parents don't require, expect and demand their child complete their homework?

Don't wait until your child is the school shooter to let us know your child is struggling mentally. Don't wait until your child is ineligible for sports or the day before report cards to check grades and question the teacher on why your child is failing.

Be a parent. Be involved in your child's life so that you can help them through the issues with friends, the possible suicidal thoughts, and problems academically. I promise you, if parents spent more time with their children and got involved in their lives, we would see drastic improvements in our schools and our society.

As parents, our job is to grow the most amazing humans possible. It's the most important job in the world. The education and emotional stability a parent provides is priceless."



Agua Caliente tribe and desert water agencies settle lawsuits, seek major federal funds

The tribe's historic water rights are affirmed in the agreement, placing them at the head of the line for water from a vast aquifer stretching under much of the Coachella Valley, but they agreed to share it in times of drought or water restrictions. Congress must approve the proposed settlement, and the tribe and the agencies will also ask for \$500 million in federal funds and \$15 million in state funds under new legislation.

More than 2,700 acres of the 280,000-acre Santa Rosa and San Jacinto Mountains National Monument currently managed by the Bureau of Reclamation would also be transferred in trust for the tribe's use and benefit to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

In a second complaint [filed in 2020](#), the tribe asserted that it and its members should not have to pay a "replenishment assessment charge" for groundwater production on land it and individual tribe members own.

Spokeswomen for the tribe and the water agencies declined to answer any questions, instead referring The Desert Sun to the lengthy [settlement agreement](#) and [FAQ sheet](#). It was not immediately clear if the tribe would pay what CVWD had billed them as \$230,000 in overdue replenishment assessment fees in 2020, or if the tribe is currently paying or would pay the fees moving forward.

How the lawsuit began

The Agua Caliente tribe first sued the water agencies in 2013, contending it has a priority right to groundwater under its lands, which include much of downtown Palm Springs and other portions of the valley. The tribe also noted its groundwater supply levels were declining and expressed concerns about water contamination. Courts agreed with the tribe's contention about its right to water, but portions of its claim, including harm, were struck down.

While things can gradually change over time, in a given year, most prognosticators can get a good measure on which states will vote for whom, at least outside of the battleground sites.

For example, states like [California](#) and [New York](#) are reliably deep blue year-to-year, at least in recent politics.

If controversial billionaire activist George Soros has anything to say about it, however, one won't be able to pick just any other Southern state anymore.

A Soros-backed group, "Texas Majority," is trying to turn the Lone Star State blue, and – unsurprisingly – there's a lot of money behind it.

"Texas Majority PAC, a Soros-funded PAC, launched a 'Blue Texas' initiative Monday along with the Texas Democratic Party and a group of county parties, aiming to organize tens of thousands of volunteers, recruit candidates and boost turnout ahead of the 2026 midterm elections," [The Wall Street Journal](#) reported.

The outlet added: *"Soros, the billionaire investor and philanthropist, has devoted millions to turning Texas blue in the past and donated \$2.1 million to Texas Majority in 2024 and \$1 million in April, records show."*

Gov. Gavin Newsom. to cut \$11.2 Billion in healthcare for citizens, while budgeting \$12 Billion in free healthcare for illegal migrants



The California Democrat State Budget Plan contains a “poison pill” according to state Rep. Carl DeMaio who says the 2025-26 California state budget cuts \$11.2 billion in healthcare for “needy citizens” to fund \$12.1 billion in free healthcare for “illegal immigrants.”

California faces a \$12 billion budget deficit for the 2025-26 fiscal year, part of a broader \$39.3 billion shortfall.

Governor Newsom’s revised \$321.9 billion budget includes **\$11.2 Billion in cuts targeting Medi-Cal, the state’s Medicaid program serving 15 million low-income residents.**

The California Department of Finance reported in February that healthcare spending on illegal migrants reached \$9.5 billion in the 2024-25 fiscal year, \$3.1 billion over the \$6.4 billion estimate.

Plaintiff Wins Unanimous Supreme Court Ruling



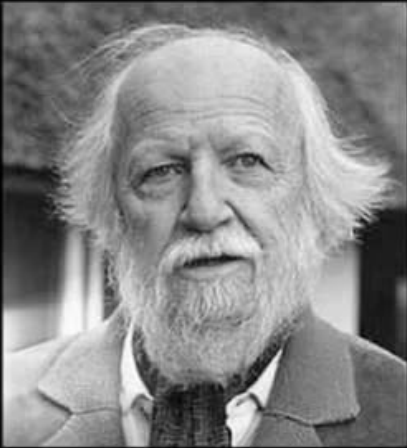

The Supreme Court has ruled that Marlean Ames may proceed with her discrimination complaint against the Ohio Department of Youth Services. The court determined that she does not need to meet a higher burden of proof when alleging discrimination. Ames claimed she was denied a promotion in favor of a less qualified lesbian candidate.

In a unanimous 9-0 decision, the court found that the dismissal of Ames’ case by two lower courts was unwarranted. The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals had ruled that Ames, as a straight woman, needed additional “background circumstances” to support her claims.

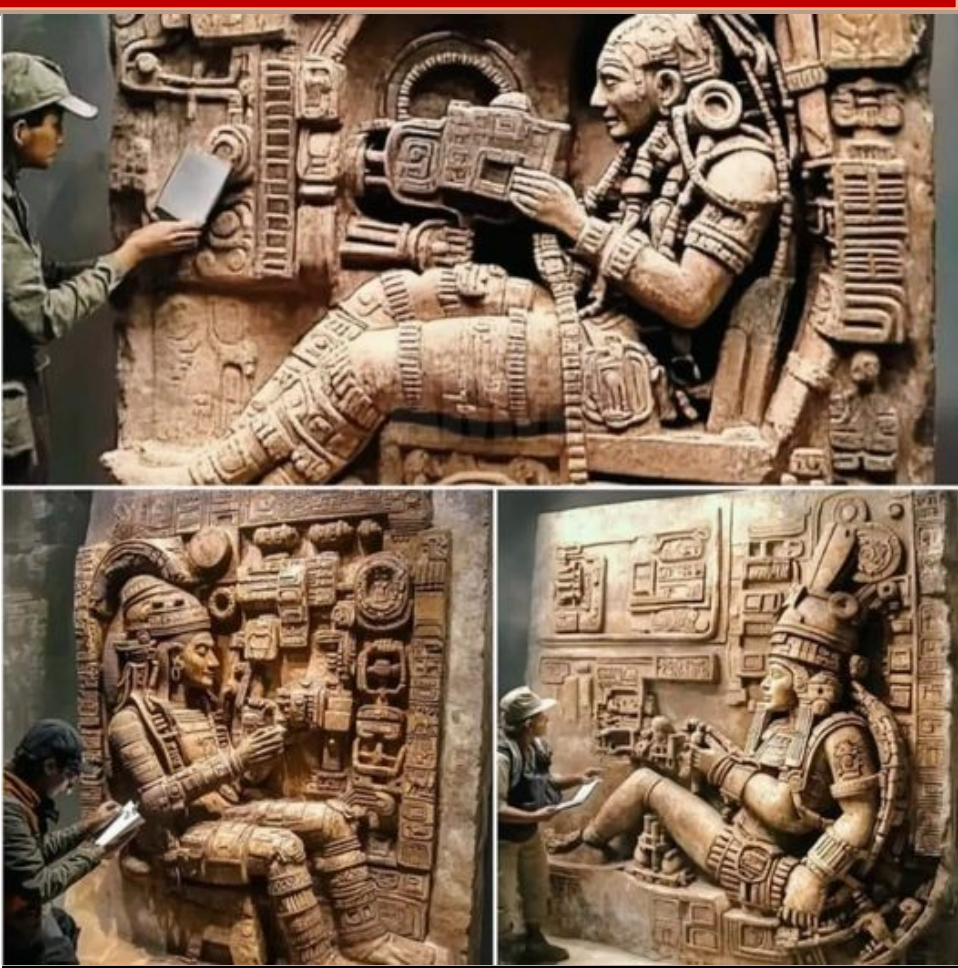

Officers injured as Portland rioters breach ICE building with explosives and rocks

Multiple police officers were injured in Portland, Oregon Saturday night during a violent riot at an Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) facility.

A mob launched fireworks, smoke grenades and threw rocks at federal law enforcement, as they broke glass and **forcibly entered the ICE facility**, Homeland Security Assistant Secretary Tricia McLaughlin told Fox News Digital.


Four officers were injured during the attack, though federal law enforcement was able to secure the facility.

"Portland rioters are violently targeting federal law enforcement and we won't sit idly by and watch these cowards,"

McLaughlin said. *"Our officers are facing a 413% increase in assaults against them as they put their lives on the line to arrest murderers, rapists, and gang members."*

DHS said it will not be deterred from enforcing the law.

"We will NOT be deterred by rioters' intimidation and threats," DHS wrote in the post. *"ICE immigration enforcement will only ramp up. The violent targeting of law enforcement in Portland, OR by lawless rioters is despicable, and its leaders must call for it to end."*
