Federal judges are continuing their pushback against the Trump administration by issuing orders blocking a number of actions, including the deportation of the family of Mohamed Soliman, who is facing a hate crime charge in the wake of a firebombing attack in Colorado.

The rulings - some from judges appointed under the Biden administration come after White House Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt said last week that "President Trump had more injunctions in one full month of office in February than Joe Biden had in three years."

"The real constitutional crisis is taking place within our judicial branch, where district court judges in liberal districts across the country are abusing their power to unilaterally block President Trump's basic executive authority," Leavitt also has








It's not the first time Waters, who has served in Congress since 1991, has faced ethical financial problems. The House Ethics Committee also formally accused Waters of violating conflict of interest rules in 2010, claiming she was giving government help to a bank with ties to her husband. The Committee eventually dismissed the case but Waters' chief of staff was reprimanded.



President **Donald Trump** celebrated a federal appeals court ruling Thursday that granted him a temporary legal victory in his use of military force on U.S. soil, allowing the National Guard to remain deployed and under his control in Los Angeles as immigration protests stretch into their second week.

The decision, handed down Thursday night by the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals, paused an earlier ruling by U.S. District Judge Charles Breyer, who found the president's deployment unlawful and ordered control of the Guard returned to California Gov. **Gavin Newsom**.

The legal whiplash, pausing Breyer's 36-page rebuke just two hours after it dropped, left Los Angeles caught between two clashing branches of government and a national debate over presidential power, immigration enforcement, and military presence in civilian life.

While things can gradually change over time, in a given year, most prognosticators can get a good measure on which states will vote for whom, at least outside of the battleground sites.

For example, states like California and New York are reliably deep blue year-to-year, at least in recent politics.

If controversial billionaire activist George Soros has anything to say about it, however, one won't be able to pick just any other Southern state anymore.

A Soros-backed group, "Texas Majority," is trying to turn the Lone Star State blue, and -unsurprisingly -- there's a lot of money behind it.

"Texas Majority PAC, a Soros-funded PAC, launched a 'Blue Texas' initiative Monday along with the Texas Democratic Party and a group of county parties, aiming to organize tens of thousands of volunteers, recruit candidates and boost turnout ahead midterm elections, "The Wall Street Journal reported.

The outlet added: "Soros, the billionaire investor and philanthropist, has devoted millions to turning Texas blue in the past and donated \$2.1 million to Texas Majority in 2024 and \$1 million in April, records show."

Plaintiff Wins Unanimous Supreme Court Ruling Read More @ The Raleigh News & Observer

The Supreme Court has ruled that Marlean Ames may proceed with her discrimination complaint against the Ohio Department of Youth Services. The court determined that she does not need to meet a higher burden of proof when alleging discrimination. Ames claimed she was denied a promotion in favor of a less qualified lesbian candidate.

In a unanimous 9-0 decision, the court found that the dismissal of Ames' case by two lower courts was unwarranted. The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals had ruled that Ames, as a straight woman, needed additional "background circumstances" to support her claims.

California faces a \$12 billion budget deficit for the 2025-26 fiscal year, part of a broader \$39.3 billion shortfall.




