### Peltier Goes Home

First, I want to thank you for your sacrifice & dedication to the improvement of the quality of life for our people.

And although you have been released from prison, you're still not a free man. The irony is that it has been over a 100 plus-years since an American Indian leader has been confined to the "Reservation."

Although we never met we share the vision of our people being freed from the totalitarian and oppressive rule of the U.S. Government, its bureaucracy and its refusal to honor our Basic Treaty Rights.

And even though the days of armed resistance, Alcatraz and the American Indian Movement have long past the battles of protecting the Rights of our people continue in the courtrooms of American as they are under consistent challenges.

The majority of American people, including a large number of our own tribal folks don't understand the political oppressive norms during the 60's & 70's which included the open racism as well as the corrupt policies of Hoovers FBI. Yes, FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover died on May 2, 1972, before Wounded Knee, but his corrupt legacy still lives on.

American Indians in the mid-west were called "Prairie Niggers," women of child bearing age were unknowingly sterilized by Indian Health Service doctors and Tribal people treated inhumanly. Even to this day the media continues the distortion of the June 26, 1975 gun battle at the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation on that infamous day, including why you and others AIM brothers and sisters were there in the first place.

My brother, Bobby and I became active in the brotherhood in the mid-70's upon befriending Dennis Banks. I believe it was around the time of the incident in Oregon. A few months later California Governor Brown gave him protection from extradition.

During a June 8, 2024, interview by Native News Online, Peltier's serving attorney Kevin Sharp - who has also served as U.S. District Judge for the Middle District of Tennessee from 2011 to 2017, including as Chief Judge from 2014 to 2017 - stated the following:

*'Pine Ridge was a powder keg with the Goon Squad*

*saults in a three-year timeframe. When plain-clothed agents in unmarked cars arrived, a firefight ensued. Leonard did not shoot the agents, and the FBI knew this but withheld evidence. The court of appeals acknowledged this but couldn't overturn the conviction due to legal standards. Judge Heaney, who wrote the opinion, later supported clemency for Leonard. Now, 38 of Judge Heaney's former clerks support parole for Leonard, including three who worked on his case. The government admits they don't know who killed the agents, but it wasn't Leonard. It's time to release Leonard and start the healing process.'*

*June 26, 1975: "The two agents had fired a total of five shots: two from Williams' handgun, one from Coler's handgun, one from Coler's rifle, and one from Coler's shotgun. In total, 125 bullet holes were found in the agents' vehicles, many from a .223 Remington AR-15 rifle. Coler was 28 years old and Williams was 27."*

Some organizations have raised doubts about Peltier's guilt and the fairness of his trial, based on alleged inconsistencies in the FBI and prosecution's handling of the case. Two witnesses in the initial trial recanted their statements and stated they were made under duress at the hands of the FBI. At least one witness was given immunity from prosecution in exchange for testimony against Peltier.

**Darlene "Kamook" Nichols**, former wife of the AIM leader **Dennis Banks**, testified that in late 1975, Peltier told of shooting the FBI agents. He was talking to a small group of AIM activists who were fugitives from law enforcement. Nichols testified that Peltier said, *"The motherfucker was begging for his life, but I shot him anyway."*

During the trial, **Darlene "Kamook" Nichols** acknowledged receiving \$42,000 from the FBI in connection with her cooperation on the case. She said it was compensation for travel expenses to collect evidence and moving expenses to be farther from her ex-husband **Dennis Banks**, whom she feared because

she had implicated him as a witness. Peltier has claimed that **Kamook Nichols** committed perjury with her testimony.

No investigation has been opened into the allegedly perjured testimony of **Kamook Nichols**, now married to a former FBI Chief Agent and living under the name **Darlene Ecoffey**.

**End of Wikipedia excerpts, the free encyclopedia** **Dennis Banks** and **Peltier** made their way to California in search of money and transportation. Actor **Marlon Brando** gave them \$10,000 in cash and a motorhome RV. They met with several other supporter as they drove back to the **Pine Ridge Indian Reservation** in South Dakota to drop off the majority of the money for food and supplies as many of the AIM supporters were still under siege by the **Goon Squad** and **FBI**.

However according to **Banks**, they were stopped by an Oregon state trooper who panicked and started shooting as **Banks** and **Peltier** ran for their lives. **Peltier** made his way to Canada while **Banks** found his way to CA.

## US Justice Department accuses judge reviewing Trump transgender military ban of misconduct

The complaint said U.S. District Judge Ana Reyes in Washington, D.C., violated the judicial code of conduct by disrespecting a Justice Department lawyer and failing to uphold the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary. During two hearings in the case this week, she said "WTF" - a coarse expression of incredulity - questioned a lawyer about religion and used him as a prop in a "rhetorical exer-

cise," the complaint said. The complaint was signed by Attorney General Pam Bondi's chief of staff, Chad Mizelle, and lodged with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit. Reyes, an appointee of Democratic former President Joe Biden, is expected to rule soon on whether to block Trump's ban pending the outcome of a

Sky's discovery won her the First Grand Prize at the science fair, surpassing 440+ projects. She believes the decline in traditional nutrition contributes to diseases like diabetes. Now, she's researching whether chokecherry's medicinal compounds can target other types of cancer. The results were astonishing—pudding made with crushed chokecherry pits stopped cancer cell growth, killing the cells within 24 hours. Science Fair. She scientifically demonstrated that chokecherry pudding, a traditional Native American recipe, has powerful cancer-fighting properties.

## HOW A TRIBE WON A LEGAL BATTLE AGAINST THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INDIAN EDUCATION – AND STILL LOST

**SUPAI, Ariz. — Kambria Siyuja** always felt like the smartest kid in Supai.

Raised by educators in this tribal village at the base of the Grand Canyon, she started kindergarten a little ahead of her peers. Her teachers at Havasupai Elementary School often asked Siyuja to tutor younger students and sometimes even let her run their classrooms. She graduated valedictorian of her class.

But once she left the K-8 school at the top of her grade, Siyuja stopped feeling so smart.

*“I didn’t know math or basic formulas,”* she said. *“Typing and tech? Nonexistent.”*

Siyuja, now 22, wiped tears from her face as she sat alongside her mother and grandmother — the educators of the family — one afternoon last year in the Havasupai Tribal Council chambers. The trio wept as they recalled Siyuja’s move as a teenager to a private boarding school 150 miles away in Sedona, Arizona, which she’d chosen to attend because the federal agency that runs Havasupai Elementary, the only school in her village, provides no options for high school.

Once there, however, Siyuja discovered how little she’d learned at the Supai school. She had only superficial familiarity with state and U.S. history, and knew none of the literature her peers had read years earlier. She was the only freshman who’d never taken pre-algebra.

In 2017, six Havasupai families sued the federal government, alleging that the Bureau of Indian Education, which operates Havasupai Elementary and is housed within the Interior Department, deprived their children of their federal right to an education.

The tribe, in a brief supporting the lawsuit, argued that the bureau had allowed Havasupai Elementary to become *“the worst school in a deplorable BIE system”* and that court intervention was required to protect students from the agency.

The families eventually secured two historic settlements that fueled hopes across Indian Country that true reform might finally improve outcomes both in Supai and perhaps also at BIE schools throughout the U.S.

So far, the settlements have brought new staff to Supai, and the BIE had

to reconstitute the school board. Teachers now must use lesson plans, and they finally have a curriculum to use in English, science and math classes. A new principal pledged to stay longer than a school year.

*“We now have some teachers and some repairs to the building that are being done,”* said Dinolene Kaska, a mother to three former students and a new school board member. *“It has been a long time just to get to this point.”*

The legal wins followed an effort to reform the BIE as a whole. In 2014, federal officials unveiled a sweeping plan to overhaul the beleaguered bureau, which had long struggled to deliver better student outcomes with anemic funding. If the BIE were a state, the schools it operates would rank at or very near the bottom of any list for academic achievement.

But in the past decade, and after a nearly doubling of its budget, the BIE has finally started to make some progress. Graduation rates have improved, staff vacancies are down and the bureau built its own data system to track and support student achievement across its

183 campuses in 23 different states. Now, those milestones could be at risk.

President Donald Trump, in his seismic restructuring of the federal government, laid off thousands of workers that will trigger deep cuts to the BIE, among other agencies that work directly on Indian Country. **The White House in January also issued an executive order to turn the BIE into a school choice program**, draining the bureau of funding and, according to some advocates in Washington, D.C., threatening the government’s long-established trust responsibility to tribal nations. It also remains unclear how the policy would benefit families in isolated communities like Supai where other schooling options are scant or non-existent.

*“Tribes in rural areas don’t have a lot of school choice,”* said Quinton Roman Nose, executive director of the Tribal Education Departments National Assembly, a nonprofit that works with tribal education agencies. *“For Native students, that’s not a good model. I don’t think it’s going to work for so many.”*

### As Media Freaks Over 1 DOGE Employee Getting IRS Access, We Learn Biden Gave 919 People Access

The Trump administration's Department of Government Efficiency is about to provide a staff member access to IRS data, causing the media and the Democrats to spin into a frenzy.

Gavin Klinger, a software engineer who works at DOGE, will be based at the IRS for 120 days, and he will reportedly have access to the tax agency's data, according to a Monday report from CNN.

Klinger will work as a senior adviser for the IRS acting commissioner.

"Waste, fraud, and abuse have been deeply entrenched in our broken system for far too long. It takes direct access to the system to identify and fix it," White House deputy press secretary Harrison Fields told CNN about the move.

"DOGE will continue to shine a light on the fraud they uncover as the American people deserve to know what their government has been spending their hard earned tax dollars on," he added.

But CNN was deeply concerned about the fact that Klinger would receive access to private data,

like Social Security numbers, bank account information, and tax returns.

The outlet breathlessly quoted a letter from Oregon Democratic Sen. Ron Wyden and Massachusetts Democratic Sen. Elizabeth Warren, in which they asked the acting commissioner to "immediately disclose to the Senate Committee on Finance the full extent of the potential access to IRS systems and data granted to DOGE team members."

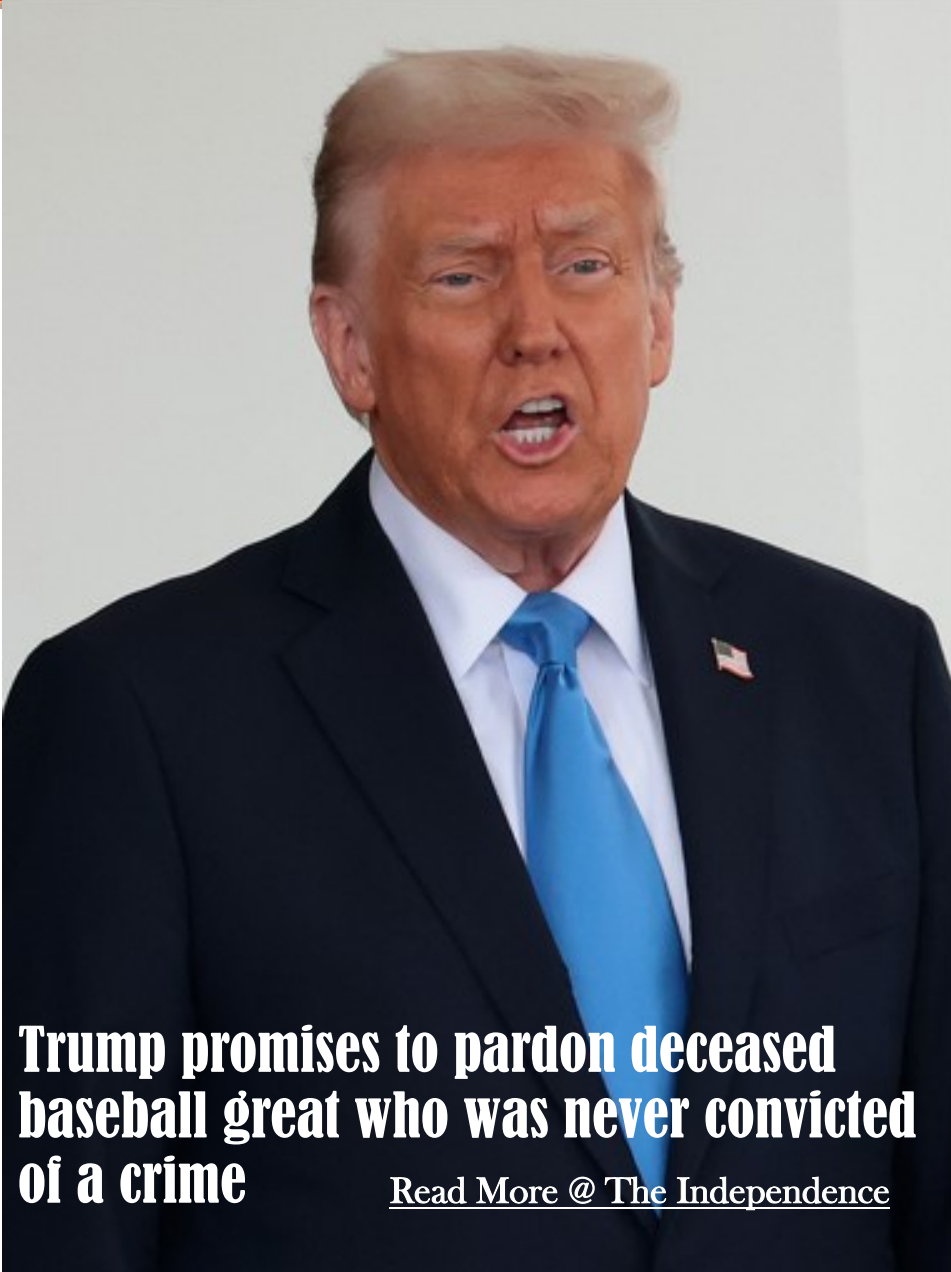

## Trump promises to pardon deceased baseball great who was never convicted of a crime

## NO PLAYER IN MLB HISTORY HAS MORE HITS THAN PETE ROSE (4,256)

Just hours after Donald Trump shocked the world by chastising Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky in the Oval Office, the president took to his TruthSocial page to promise to pardon baseball great Pete Rose.

Rose, who died last year at 83, was banned from baseball for life. He admitted in 2004 that he had bet on games, though never against his own team. "Over the next few weeks I will be signing a complete pardon of Pete Rose, who shouldn't have been gambling on baseball, but only bet on his team winning," Trump posted on Truth Social.

*"He never betted against himself, or the other team. He had the most hits, by far, in baseball history, and won more games than anyone in sports history."*

Trump did not say what the pardon would cover, as Rose was not convicted of a crime. The commander-in-chief made a similar plea during his first term in February 2020 and again in 2024.

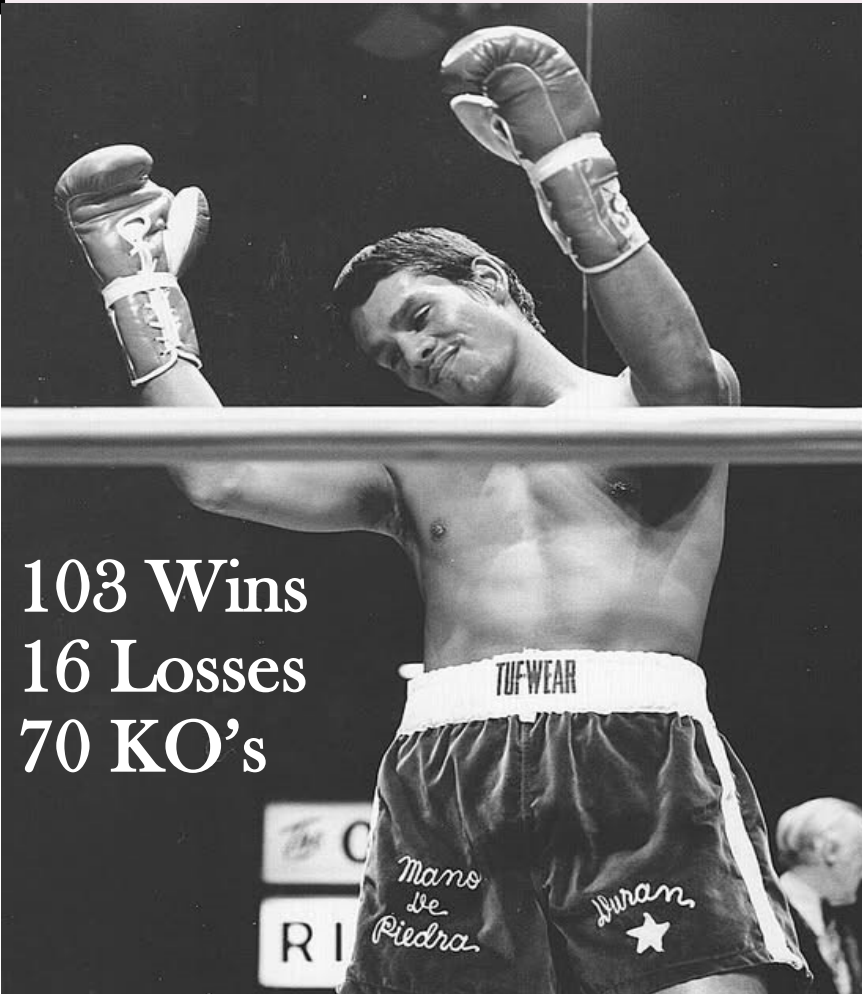
Nicknamed "Charlie Hustle" for his tenacious playing style, the switch-hitting Rose amassed a record 4,256 hits in his career. His 3,562 games

and 14,053 at-bats are also MLB records. Rose was named an All-Star 17 times and won the NL MVP in 1973. He was a key part of the Cincinnati Reds' "Big Red Machine" that won back-to-back World Series titles in 1975 and 1976. He clinched a third championship with the Philadelphia Phillies in 1980.

Rose won three batting titles and his lifetime average was .303. He hit 160 home runs and was renowned for his speed and fearless head first slides.
